Jezza's Guide to Bristol - a brilliant, personal site set up by someone who lives in Bristol, with lots of links to relevant pages. Informative and attractive with a nice uncomplicated layout.

The Evening Post website - news, sport, entertainment, classified ads (as you would expect), with a "Things to see in Bristol" section.
3. [www.about-bristoi.co.uk](http://www.about-bristoi.co.uk)  
A series of pictorial tours of Bristol - buildings, landmarks, open spaces and statues. Linked to site 11 (brisindex) and site 12 (bristolweb).
4. [www.bristoi-citv.gov.uk](http://www.bristoi-citv.gov.uk)  
Bristol City Council's website. Includes information on council services, arts and leisure, tourist information etc.
5. [www.bbc.co.uk/bristol](http://www.bbc.co.uk/bristol)  
The BBC Bristol website. Mostly local news and what's on.
6. [www.venue.co.uk](http://www.venue.co.uk)  
What's on, food and drink, events, clubs etc - the website of Bristol and Bath's fortnightly magazine.

Basically a directory of local business and organisations, but has a list of local community sites e.g. Easton, Fishponds in various stages of development.

Bristol Tourism and Conference Bureau. A plain, rather wordy site. The attractions are not very attractive!

A colourful directory of local websites or addresses of local organisations. Covers 20 different categories including: local history, community, business, faiths and beliefs, arts and culture.

10. **[www.bristol-online.com](http://www.bristol-online.com)**

A directory of links to local websites. Includes businesses, services, leisure and entertainment. Clear, easy to use format, with a subject search facility.

11. **[www.brisindex.co.uk](http://www.brisindex.co.uk)**

A directory of Bristol businesses and services. Gives brief details only, and links where possible. Linked to site 3 (about-bristol) and site 12 (bristolweb).

12. **[www.bristolweb.co.uk](http://www.bristolweb.co.uk)**

A directory of local businesses. Gives addresses and phone numbers only. Linked to site 3 (about-bristol) and site 11 (brisindex).

13. **[www.bristol.net](http://www.bristol.net)**

Rather anonymous and not local. A directory of online shopping and service sites.

14. **[www.bristol-link.co.uk](http://www.bristol-link.co.uk)**

An attempt to bring together on-line community sites. Very wordy, and not easy to find any real information.
